

Environmental Policy

This environmental policy covers all operations of Compost London C.I.C. and commits us to choosing suppliers and services which adhere to environmentally sound ways of operating.

Compost London C.I.C is committed to promoting good environmental practice and sustainability in the conduct of its activities while ensuring that any adverse effects on the environment are kept to a minimum. We will:

- Minimise the reduction of waste where possible by thinking about what we buy and how we use it. Non-essential documents and emails will not be printed and wherever practicable/possible photocopying and printing will be done on double-sided setting.
- Endeavour to avoid disposable cups and food packaging for events.
- Re-use wherever possible by trying to find a second life for items such as paper, envelopes and packaging.
- Encourage efficient use of energy, utilities and natural resources, especially where these are non-renewable.
- Operate a travel policy that takes account of environmental issues and encourages the use of cycling, walking and public transport as the main means of travel to local meetings. For journeys that require the use of a car sharing will be encouraged.
- Purchase products and services that do the least damage to the environment and encourage others to do the same.

Compost London C.I.C. will ensure all staff and volunteers understand our environmental policy and conform to the high standards required.
